NOT ACCEPTED

If we have it on this list, it is either because it is illegal for us to sell or we have tried to sell in the past and it doesn't get bids. Please use common sense when bringing items over. We will not take:

- **ANYTHING** that is damaged, broken, is missing pieces, or is stained.
- **ANYTHING** from a household that's been smoked in.
- **ANYTHING** that's been exposed to unsanitary conditions, either directly or indirectly, from humans or animals.
- Baby Equipment (recall risk)
- Books & Modern Magazines
- Clothing and Shoes (New or Used)
- Clothing Hangers
- Collectibles such as:
 - Collector Plates
 - Porcelain Dolls
 - Precious Moments

HOW IT WORKS

1 Asset Assessment

Typically, we'll discuss what you have to sell or come to take a look at what you have. We'll give you guidance based on our years of experience. See the list on the back of this sheet for more information.

2 Agreement

We'll get all the details down in the agreement so everyone knows what to expect when we begin the process.

3 Cataloging

We provide accurate descriptions and take detailed photos of each item. From sizes to functionality and any other details bidders need to assess value, we've got it covered. We carefully store and organize the items, making them easy to locate at pickup.

4 Bidding Begins

Auctions run for about 2 weeks, giving us ample time to promote to the right audience. REMEMBER: Most of the bidding takes place in the last few hours, so don't lose heart if your items don't get bids right away.

5 Closing

Our auctions close at a scheduled date and time, with items typically ending at a rate of 2-4 lots per minute, depending on the size of the auction.

6 Pickup

Once the auction ends, invoices are promptly sent to the winning bidders. Winners arrive at the auction location to pay for their items. We personally retrieve each person's items to ensure everything is accounted for and nothing goes home with the wrong bidder.

For certain items, we also offer shipping, which is paid for by the winning bidder. Offering shipping helps expand the bidder base and increases competition, ensuring the best results for everyone involved!

7 Payment

You can expect to receive a detailed settlement report and a check within 14 days of the auction's final pickup date.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens if an item doesn't sell?

You maintain ownership of it. Special rules apply for firearms.

Why won't you sell certain items?

Sometimes, it's illegal to sell certain items - used mattresses, migratory waterfowl, etc. We are tapped into the market and know what will sell and what won't. If we know something won't sell, we won't put it on the auction. We reserve the right to refuse any items we deem unfit for auction, even if they're on the "accepted" list.

Can I put a reserve on my items?

We can add a reserve for items with a value over \$3,000, but we aren't big fans of them. They tend to take the fun out of the auction process and deter people from bidding. The auction format truly reflects the current market. Fees for adding reserves are noted in our agreement.

Can I bid on my own items?

We don't encourage anyone to bid on their own items. If you happen to bid on your own items, and you happen to win them back, you'll be expected to pay all taxes and fees shown on the invoice we send you. After buying something back, we will not sell it for you again.

KEEP IN MIND

- **The price people ask on eBay is NOT the price that items are actually selling for.** To get a more realistic idea of the market price of items, look at eBay's SOLD and COMPLETED listings. A person can ask \$300 for a candy dish, but they aren't necessarily going to get it.
- Retail prices are usually not realized on an online auction. We have a great mix of collectors and resellers as customers. We also have a large enough bidder base (which grows daily) to create healthy competition between bidders, but items sell for what the market dictates. We can't force people to bid.
- Do not panic if you see your items aren't getting bids right away. Most of the bidding is done in the last 8 hours or so.
- Share the link to the auction on social media. The more exposure the better!

For our auctions, we go the extra mile to provide more photos than most auctioneers in the market.

Why? Because we understand that not everyone has the time to inspect items in person. By capturing clear, comprehensive photos and providing detailed descriptions, we aim to benefit both buyers and sellers. Quality matters to us, and we strive to showcase your items in the best possible light.
